The Podiatry unit has been operational in Bon Secours Hospital, Dublin for almost two years. A Podiatrist is a clinician that specialises in the evaluation and treatment of conditions affecting the foot. The Podiatry unit runs on Mondays and includes a variety of services including:

- Biomechanical Assessment
- Provision of Custom made Orthoses and Insoles
- Diabetes Footcare Education and Treatment
- Rheumatoid Footcare
- Routine Foot Care

The Podiatry Unit is situated on St Anthony's Corridor near the Dietician's clinic and the Diabetes Specialist Nurse.
